Regulations limit the number of visitors that can be at the facility at any given time.**

## **Protect Yourself and Your Loved Ones From COVID-19**

- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use Alcohol Based Hand Sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick and stay home if you are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Remember to maintain social distancing precautions of at least 6 feet from your loved one and all other residents.

## **Visitor Guidance**

- Bring documentation of a negative COVID test completed within the last 7 days.
- Visitors must sign in and will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to the visit.
- You must wear a face mask or face covering over your nose and mouth at all times while on the premises (inside or outside). Residents must also wear a facemask over their nose and mouth when visiting with loved ones. If you do not have a facemask, we will provide you with one.
- Visits cannot take place in resident rooms or resident care areas unless otherwise specified.
- Hand sanitizer will be used before and after the visit and as needed.
- There will be no more than 2 visitors per session.
- Visitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Residents with COVID 19 or signs and symptoms are not eligible for visits.
- If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.
